Restrictions:

Categories with less than five (5) competitors will be combined at tournament director's discretion. We have the option of separating categories based on the number of competitors, age and height.

*First Timers division is the competitors that have not competed in any previous tournaments.



TOURNAMENT RULES

KATA

- * Simultaneous execution for all categories except the WKF Elite.
- * All Beg & Nov. must perform Kihon Kata and can repeat the same Kata.
- * All Intermediates cannot perform advanced Kata (refer to the list), can repeat same Kata in all the rounds.
- * All advanced level must perform a different Kata in medal rounds. It must be different than the Kata performed in the previous round.
- * If Int. / Adv. Combined, they can repeat the same kata in all the rounds.
- * WKF Elite categories must perform a different kata in each round.
- * DO NOT disqualify any Beg. /Nov. divisions under any circumstances. If any competitors in this category comes to a full stop, have them repeat the kata then proceed to Hantei.
- * Disqualification due to the lack of a bow(s) will be done only in WKF/Elite divisions.
- * Participation medals are ONLY for under 11 yrs old who did not place in Kata or Kumite.
- * Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate categories will NOT have repecharge.
- * All Advanced and WKF Elite categories 12 years and up will have repecharge.
- * All categories will have two third place finalists in Kata.
- * CASH PRICES! For Elite Category Men and Female GOLD medalist Adults 18 34 YRS ONLY! \$300.00 each.

KUMITE

- * Only licensed referees can function as the center referee or Kansa. No Video Review.
- * Only judges who has participated on local Seminars can work as corner judges.
- * Three-Judges system: Judges will indicate points, penalties and jogai, unless the referee says otherwise.
- * Five-Judges system: WKF Rules Apply
- * Fights last 1 ½ minutes for everyone 13 years or younger. 8-point ceiling.
- * Fights last 2 minutes for 12-15 years of age WKF and 18 & up NON-Elite categories. 8-point ceiling.
- * Fights will last 3 minutes for all Elite 16-17 years and Senior WKF/Elite Male and Female categories. 8-point spread.
- * "Skin touch" to the face with gloves is allowed for those 16 and over.
- * "Light touch" head kicks are permitted for 14-15 and over.
- * ALL competitors must wear shin pads and footies, gloves and groin cup (boys).
- * In all Non-Elite categories, competitors are allowed to use White shin pads and footies.
- * No jewelry is permitted.
- * Headgear is optional for all categories.
- * Beginner, Novice, and Intermediate divisions will NOT have repecharge.
- * All Advanced and WKF Elite divisions 12 years and up will have repecharge.
- * All divisions will have two third place finalists in Kumite.
- * CASH PRICES! For Elite Category Men and Female GOLD Kilo Adults 18 – 34 YRS ONLY! \$100.00 each.
- * CASH PRICES! For Elite Category Man and Female GOLD Open Weight Category Adults 18 34 YRS ONLY! \$300.00 each.

KATAS

Beginner and Novice Categories may perform only the katas as shown on the green table below. Intermediate categories may perform only the katas as shown on the yellow table below.

All Competitors will compete simultaneously in all Categories, except Black Belt Adults and Elite athletes.

Elite Kata will be scored with tablets in accordance with current WKF rules. All others will have flags.

KUMITE

The Elite divisions for Kumite will be separated based on Age and Weigh as follows:

If there is less than three competitors in some divisions, AKR will have the right to combine with other divisions, taken into consideration age and experience competing.

The Elite divisions winners (1st Places), in all divisions for Kata and Kumite, will receive a beautiful Gold medal and a CASH Prize.

USA-NKF Modified Kumite Rules

All techniques to the face, head and neck must have absolute control. The referee panel will penalize the competitor if the hand or foot touches the face, head or neck according to the guideline as described below:

13 years old and younger: hand or foot techniques <u>Cannot</u> touch the face
14-15 years old: only controlled foot technique SKIN-TOUCH to the face
16 and older: hand and foot techniques SKIN-TOUCH to the face
